Kitchen Korner

I have asked all those who took the Food Handlers Course to submit a copy of their certificate to have on file. Apparently, I was mistaken in believing that the City would send the branch a pass/fail list.

There are several reasons for needing copies on file, the two main ones being:

- The branch paid the cost of the course and is entitled to know who passed and is able to supervise the kitchen and/or work alone in the kitchen.
- 2. Historically, health inspections occur when the kitchen is not in operation, which means that we will need to provide proof that we have certified people.

Now that the better weather is here (I hope), we can expect Fish and Chips to pick up after the winter doldrums. BUT... We need someone to take over scheduling for Fish and Chips. On Friday, March 20, the main fridge in the kitchen was found to be not working properly. As much as possible was moved out, and very little product lost. The Building and Grounds officer was notified, and a service call was

placed. The problem was a gas leak, the second time I remember this happening. The service man recommended that vinegar not be stored in the fridge in future, as the vinegar containers are open. There is corrosion within the fridge, and the vinegar is adding to it. Also, vegetables should not be stored in this fridge except on a very short term basis for similar reasons.

All I can say is TG this didn't happen the week previously when the fridge was full of product for St. Paddy's Day. That could have been a major disaster.

We will need to replace the fridge in the near future.
