Both our gaming operations did very well in March. As more than 40% of our bingo revenue and more than 95% of our revenues from 50/50 draws go back into the community, we will donate \$1250 this month, in equal shares to the following:

- Crysalis House
- National Service Dogs
- Hospice Care Ottawa
- The Elizabeth Bruyère Foundation
- The Canadian Red Cross Society (Eastern Ontario Division)

Crysalis House is a Kanata shelter for abused women and their children.

National Service Dogs supply specially trained companion dogs to veterans suffering from post-traumatic stress disorder. One of our own members has recently received a dog from this organization. Unfortunately, we were not permitted to make a \$3000 donation from the Poppy Trust Fund, so we will have to make regular smaller donations.

Hospice Care Ottawa is an amalgam of such facilities throughout Ottawa.

The Canadian Red Cross operates an antibullying initiative in schools. It is the result of the initiative of our member and City Councillor Allan Hubley - a man who makes a contribution wherever he turns his hand.

Finally, I welcome George Royle to the General Trust Fund Committee. No member of this branch was willing to spend an hour and a half in a very pleasant breakfast meeting each month helping funnel donations to worthy causes in the community. (In response to my call for help in a previous newsletter, I asked George, who is currently a member of another branch, to help us and he immediately agreed.) Thanks, George. It's a treat to find someone who cares about the less fortunate, the elderly and our youth.
